**West Houston Association Support of the Charter Amendment Election to Create a Dedicated Fund for Drainage and Street Improvements in the City of Houston**

Whereas, the City of Houston faces a growing crisis with its aging drainage and street system, and

Whereas, the current estimated cost to repair, replace and upgrade these systems is in excess of \$10 billion over next 30 to 40 years, and

Whereas, the City of Houston is expected to gain 860,000 additional residents during the next 30 years greatly increasing the burden on existing infrastructure and accelerating its deterioration, and

Whereas, the City of Houston historically spent approximately \$112 million annually (FY2004-FY2009 annual average while additional \$197 million annually is funded by others) for drainage and street capital projects but future funding from these sources is significantly less or will no longer exist;

Be It Resolved, that the West Houston Association Board of Directors Endorses:

*The City of Houston Charter Amendment election to create a permanent dedicated fund and that such Charter Amendment specifically require that equitably collected monies from all properties in the City with no exceptions be paid in to said fund to be dedicated solely for drainage and street capital projects in the City of Houston.*
