- This 8- hour course will provide in-depth training on the Envision Sustainable Infrastructure Rating System. It will prepare you and authorize you to take the official online Institute for Sustainable Infrastructure credentialing test.
- The in-person training will include interactive discussions and a workship format to learn the rating system.
